

Thank you for participating in the Residential Recycling Incentive (RRI) Program. The Village of Mariemont diverted **2072.65** tons and achieved a **66.3** % diversion rate for 2022. Your community will receive a direct deposit in the amount of \$11,132.79. Review the table below to find the seven levels of funding for 2022.

Diversion Rate	RRI Dollars per Ton Recycled
Greater than 30%	\$37.03
25% - 29.99%	\$33.03
20% - 24.99%	\$29.03
15% - 19.99%	\$25.03
10% - 14.99%	\$21.03
5% - 9.99%	\$17.03
0% - 4.99%	\$13.03

## **Receiving RRI Funds**

Communities receiving RRI grants funds must place the funds in a separate account from the general fund or in a designated line item within the general fund. Communities must be able to account for expenses and show any balance carried over from unspent funds. Communities must report all RRI expenses during the reporting period on the annual application form. The District reserves the right to audit the financial records related to the RRI of all participating communities.
