RESOLUTION NO. R-13-15

TO AMEND RESOLUTION OF EXISTING PICK-UP PLAN FOR THE MARIEMONT,  
OHIO POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Mariemont, Hamilton County, Ohio met in a duly called and authorized meeting being duly called pursuant to a notice stating the time, place and purpose of the meeting received by all Council members and the following resolution was made, seconded and adopted by those present at the meeting.

WHEREAS, the eligible employees of the Village of Mariemont Police Department participate in the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund;

WHEREAS, the Council has previously adopted a pick-up of all 11.50% of the 11.50% mandatory contributions required to be paid under Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code for participating employees of the Mariemont Police Department who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund;

WHEREAS, Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund has adopted new procedures for reporting picked-up contributions in order to properly prepare 1099-R/W-2 forms for its members;

WHEREAS, the Village of Mariemont Council wishes to reaffirm, amend and/or restate its prior Resolution in order to continue the pick-up under the new procedures;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
MARIEMONT, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS DULY  
ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION I. That effective July 5, 2015, the Council of the Village of Mariemont has determined to continue to pick-up all 12.25% of the mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund through a payroll reduction.

SECTION II. Be it further resolved that said picked up contributions paid through a payroll deduction by the employer even though designated as employee contributions for state law purposes are being paid by the Village of Mariemont in lieu of said contributions by the employee.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall go into effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


