WHEREAS, an amended Agreement to continue enrollment in the Pool has been submitted to all participating Political Subdivisions for approval, and

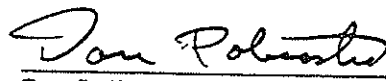
WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Mariemont does desire to continue in the joint self-insurance pool according to the terms of such amended Agreement.

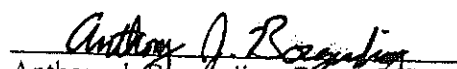

SECTION II. This Resolution shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.

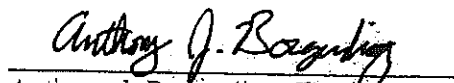
