**RESOLUTION TO CLARIFY PRIOR RESOLUTION NO. R-17-15 AND
R-7-17 RELATIVE TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE COMMUNITY
REINVESTMENT AREA ("CRA") IN THE VILLAGE OF
MARIEMONT, OHIO**

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Mariemont, Hamilton County, Ohio, previously established a Community Reinvestment Area within the Village of Mariemont pursuant to Sections 3735.65 through 3735.70 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, over the years the boundaries for said Community Reinvestment Area were expanded and clarified; and

WHEREAS, said resolutions pertaining to the Community Reinvestment Area are R-13-04, R-19-07, R-17-15, and R-7-17; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-7-17 did not clarify the exact boundaries of the CRA and Council for the Village of Mariemont is desirous of clarifying said Resolution.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE
COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARIEMONT,
HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE
MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:**

SECTION I. The boundaries of the Community Reinvestment Area as set forth in Resolution R-7-17 are hereby clarified to specify that said Community Reinvestment Area includes properties both on the north side and the south side of Murray Avenue, such that properties located at 6942 through 6998 Murray Avenue shall be included within the CRA and entitled to all benefits attendant thereto.

SECTION II. In all other terms and respects, Resolution R-7-17 shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION III. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
