RESOLUTION R-____21

TO PURCHASE A NEW POLICE CRUISER, NECESSARY EQUIPMENT, AND GRAPHICS; AND TO DECLARE EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Mariemont has determined that the Village has a need for a new police cruiser; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has authorized the Chief of Police to spend up to \$45,000.00 for a new police cruiser with the necessary additional equipment and graphics; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Mariemont recommends purchasing a new police cruiser with the necessary additional equipment and graphics for a total purchase price not to exceed Forty-five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$45,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARIEMONT, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION I. The Chief of Police is authorized to purchase a new police cruiser from Lebanon Ford, the necessary additional equipment from Cincinnati Safety Upfitters, and the graphics from A & A Safety, at a total cost not to exceed Forty-five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$45,000.00). Said purchase be funded by the Permanent Improvement Fund.

SECTION II. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of the new police car, equipment, and graphics per specifications and price as set forth in Section I of this Resolution. That the contract price of up to Forty-five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (45,000.00) for said vehicle, as described in Section I of this Resolution shall be charged to account No. 403.703.52409 Permanent Improvement Fund.

SECTION III. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and should go into immediate effect upon passage. The reason for the emergency is due to the immediate availability of the police car at a favorable cost to the Village.
