

VILLAGE OF MARIEMONT

RESOLUTION R-\_\_\_\_-21

**TO PERFORM WORK FOR PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS RELATED  
TO THE TENNIS SHED AND BATHROOMS; AND TO DECLARE EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Finance Committee has reviewed proposals for permanent improvements related to the tennis shed and bathrooms; and

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Village of Mariemont recommends acceptance of the bid of Trick Custom Construction, LLC, as the lowest and best bid to add more storage space inside the tennis shed and for renovation of the bathrooms for a total amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$30,000.00), \$10,000 of which will be reimbursed to the Village in private funds by the Tennis Association upon completion of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, in the opinion of Council of the Village of Mariemont, said recommendations should be accepted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
MARIEMONT, HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED  
THERE TO CONCURRING:**

**SECTION I.** That the bid submitted by Trick Custom Construction, LLC to add more storage space inside the tennis shed and for renovation of the bathrooms for a total amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$30,000.00) is accepted, and the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Trick Custom Construction, LLC for said work.

**SECTION II.** That the Tennis Association shall reimburse the Village in the amount of \$10,000 in private funds upon completion of the project.

**SECTION III.** That the Clerk be and is hereby authorized to pay to Trick Custom Construction, LLC the amount as set forth above and charge the same to the Permanent Improvement Fund, Account No. 403.703.52409 of the account of the Village.

**SECTION IV.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and should go into immediate effect upon passage. The reason so said emergency is so the shed project can begin in February and be completed prior to the beginning of the tennis season.
