RESOLUTION NO. R- 14 -16

TO CONFIRM THE REAPPOINTMENT OF CHRISTOPHER M. ERTEL AS  
VILLAGE ENGINEER FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2017 AND 2018, AND TO SET  
COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends to Council that Christopher M. Ertel be  
reappointed Village Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Christopher M. Ertel is a registered professional engineer and  
Council believes he is qualified to fulfill the duties of this position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
VILLAGE OF MARIEMONT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO THIRDS OF THE  
MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION I. That Council confirms the reappointment of Christopher M. Ertel  
as Village Engineer, for the calendar years of 2017 and 2018, and that he shall serve at  
the will of Council, pursuant to Section 32.22 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village  
of Mariemont. He shall be paid at the rate of \$44.58 per hour in addition to the \$1,500  
annual compensation established by Ordinance.
