TO APPOINT BRAD LOCKHART AS A MEMBER
OF THE ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW BOARD
TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF PAUL ALLEN AND FOR THE CALENDAR YEARS OF
2018 & 2019; AND TO DELARE EMERGENCY
