Based on year to date actuals, the expenses incurred by the Village are projected revenue collected via the waste and recycling fee plus the recycling rebate we receive from Hamilton 400.
the recycling thouse and \$1 increase and to 2024 would be	ing into account the 3% increase from Rumpke, in order for the Village to be breakeven (including rebate), the Village would need to increase its fees by 3.3%. Currently, the fee is \$19.00/month for a 4.26/month for an apartment and is collected via Greater Cincinnati Water Works. With a 3.3% rounding up to maintain a \$4.75 differential between houses and apartments, the proposed fees for e \$19.75/month for a house and \$15.00/month for an apartment. The committee voted unanimously new proposed fees for 2024.
