ORDINANCE NO. 0-12 -20

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF NEW TURNOUT GEAR, AN UPGRADE TO THE MOBILE DATA COMPUTERS, AND PURCHASE OF CHEST COMPRESSION SYSTEM BY THE MARIEMONT FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND TO DECLARE EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee met to discuss certain purchase requests by the Fire Department and have recommended the purchase of new turnout gear, an upgrade to the mobile data computers, and the purchase of a chest compression system for EMS; and

WHEREAS, Council has considered all of the bids that have been submitted and have determined that the purchases for new turnout gear, an upgrade to the mobile data computers, and the purchase of a chest compression system for EMS should be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MARIEMONT, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS DULY ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION I. That the Village of Mariemont shall make the following purchases:

- a. Five (5) new sets of turnout gear for a cost not to exceed \$16,975 from Phoenix Safety Outfitters.
- b. An upgrade to the mobile data computers for the total cost of \$11,950, which shall include the following:
 - five (5) Surface Pro 7 tablets with Windows 10
 Professional and five (5) Surface Pro docking stations
 (the Surface Pro equipment shall be purchased from
 the Microsoft Store in Kenwood at a cost not to exceed
 \$5,120.30);
 - 2. five (5) locking mounts for the Surface Pro (the locking mounts shall be purchased from Jotto Desk for a cost not to exceed \$1,122.06); and
 - five (5) cradle point devices, antennas, and power supply (the cradle point devices, antennas, and power supply shall be purchased from DH Wireless Solutions for a cost not to exceed \$5,707.64).
- c. A chest compression system shall be purchased from Stryker, for a total cost not to exceed \$14,881.40.

That all of said equipment shall be purchased for a total cost not to exceed \$43,806.40.

SECTION II. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of the above-listed items at a cost not to exceed \$43,806.40 as described in Section I of this Ordinance and the same shall be charged to account No. 403.703.52409, Permanent Improvement Fund.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and should go into

immediate effect upon passage. The reason for the emergency is because the equipment is in need of replacement, as it constitutes a safety hazard to our firefighters, and it is important to act quickly to insure the best prices for said purchases.
