All of the Shamrock items have been bundled and therefore given a discount if we move forward with all of the items. The majority of the items on the list are compliance items from Hamilton County. Discussion was had and all are for requesting all of these fixes.

Bottling station has a grant and Matt thinks we have a good chance of winning the Hamilton County Grant. This will not be pursued if we don't get the grant.

Audio system is a great deal as Mandy got 1 quote for \$15K so we need to jump on this deal. It is also going to be a plus that we can use for swim meets.

Alicia and Mandy are able to come to support the pool at the budget meeting on Dec 18 @ 5:30.

Discussion was had about the capital campaign and whether to try to include a diving well in addition to the zero entry pool. No quote has come back from Shamrock on the expense but the consensus was to start small with just the zero entry pool and if it is a success, we would quickly move into another campaign for the diving boards. This will all hinge on Council support.
